Signed into law in 2000, the American Competitiveness in the 21st Century Act (AC21) modernized immigration laws pertaining to foreign workers in the United States. AC21 makes greatly H-1B visa and Form I-140 portability, allowing foreign workers in certain situations the flexibility to change employers.

On October 17, 2000, the American Competitiveness in the Twenty First Century Act (often abbreviated AC21) amended the Immigration and Nationality Act (INA) regarding H1B non-immigrant workers. There are four main provisions under the AC21: Those employed by institutes of higher education or other related organizations are exempt from the H1B cap.

In 2000, Congress passed the American Competitiveness in the Twenty-First Century Act (AC21), Pub. L. No. 106-313, 114 Stat. 1251 (Oct. 17, 2000). Section 106 (c) of AC21 amended section 204 of the Act by adding the following provision, codified as 8 U.S.C. §1154 (j):
