Endocrine System Study Guide Answers

The means of control and the speed of the endocrine system are very different from those of the nervous system. The nervous system regulates the activity of muscles and glands via electrochemical impulses delivered by neurons, and those organs respond within milliseconds. The endocrine system influences metabolic activity by means of hormones, which are chemical messengers released into the blood to be transported throughout the body.
