Generally, deaf students in general education/mainstream settings demonstrate lower social competence (e.g., self-concept, self-esteem, social skills and peer relationships) (Antia, Jones, Luckner, Kreimeyer, & Reed, 2011) reporting feelings of isolation and loneliness (McCain and Shirin, 2005; Gent, Goedhart, Knoors, Westenberg, & Treffers, 2011) than those in inclusion settings.

Positive Social Competence in Mainstream Deaf Students

Research indicates that deaf children can have marked social difficulties compared with their hearing peers. Factors that influence these social interactions need to be reviewed to inform interventions. A systematic search of 5 key databases and 3 specialized journals identified 14 papers that met the inclusion criteria.

Social Competence and Sense of Loneliness of Children With Hearing Loss. Children with hearing loss (HL) may have difficulties while growing up in developing effective social strategies and SC (Preisler, Tvingstedt, & Ahlstrom, 2002).

Social Competence, Sense of Loneliness, and Speech ...

Social competence was measured with a general and deaf-specific measure. Results showed that children with hearing loss performed significantly worse than hearing peers on the general measure but better than the norms on the deaf-specific measure.

Comparisons of Social Competence in Young Children With ...

It was an adapted form of the social competence program elaborated by Segura, Mesa, & Arcas, (1997), which has been successfully implemented in recent times with hearing children in our community; (2) a social skills training program that was taught in six 1-hour sessions to both the hearing and deaf students, building on what was previously learned in the first part of the program.
