I use the large sequence picture cards to order events in my pocket chart and then use the vocabulary word bank and transition words needed to tell my story orally and later in writing. Retell stories orally! Students choose a story to order using the picture cards, then practice their language skills by orally telling a story.

Sequencing Stories With Pictures Worksheets & Teaching ...

Ask the child to pick out which step happened first and place that on a sequencing strip (like in the picture above) or just in front of them on the table. Then, ask them which step happened next. Place that one next to the first picture and finally ask the child what happened last and lay that one in the line.
